

## **006 CHEAT SHEET (Read-alongs)**

*NOTE*: 006 is unique to each item and must be determined individually. Please do not simply copy and paste the following examples into another record.

### **Record type "a" = book primary component**

### 006 for accompanying cd (non-musical recording)
